Devon Communities Together hosts the Devon Social Enterprise Network (DSEN), a network for social and community enterprises, who want to be part of a stronger united voice for social entrepreneurs. A community enterprise is a community based organisation that has both enterprising and social aims and objectives and is owned and controlled by the people who live in a community or who share other forms of common interest.

The network offers regular e-bulletins promoting local training, funding support, networking opportunities, and events, along with help and support to help drive socially enterprising ideas forward. Devon Communities Together is a partner in Enhance Social Enterprise which is a new business support programme for Social Enterprise and Social Entrepreneurs in Devon, Somerset, Plymouth and Torbay. It is funded by the European Regional Development Fund and local partners, to help strengthen and grow the Social Enterprise sector in Devon.

Transform Ageing

Transform Ageing is a pioneering programme to improve people's experience of ageing. It brings together people in later life, social entrepreneurs and health and social care leaders to define, develop and deliver new solutions that better support the needs and aspirations of our ageing communities.

Devon Communities Together is the Devon lead for this exciting new programme, working with the Design Council and other partners. During summer 2017, a series of workshops was held, using a design process to explore 5 challenges: Preventing Social Isolation • Preventing Physical & Mental Ill Health • Effective Hospital Discharge and Care at Home • Staying Active • Informal Care & Casual Interactions

The outcomes of the workshops are a set of Innovation Briefs, which form the basis for an invitation to Social Entrepreneurs who may wish to develop products/ services to answer them.

Devon Communities can support Social Entrepreneurs to prototype and develop their idea, connect with local people who can help test and evaluate them and by supporting Social Entrepreneurs apply to access the £822,500 pot of grant funding which can help bring their innovative ideas to life.

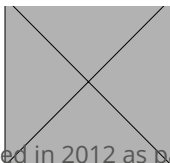
